Kindly send the soft copy of the filled application form along with the supporting documents and a proof of the online payment to the registrar of the university through Email only (registrar@tnu.in). However, please note that while sending the application through email; please make a cc to rd@tnu.in.
7. Applicants shall be informed in advance to appear before the admission test. The syllabus of the admission test shall be uploaded to the university website before the notification of the admission test. The admission test would be of 100 marks and it would be a MCQ based test. No negative marks shall be applied upon negative answer.
8. Successful candidates (qualified in admission test) shall be called for the interview.
9. Candidates qualified in both admission test and interview shall be given the offer letter to join PhD program in The Neotia University.
10. Candidates who have qualified NET/GATE/SET/equivalent exams organized by national or state level organization/statutory body need not to appear in the written test. They need to only qualify the interview to get selected for the enrolment in the PhD program.
11. The admission test and/or interview may be conducted in online/offline mode based on the decision of the competent authority of the university.
